

Camden County Joint Development Authority
Policy Governing Acceptance of Public Comment

Georgia law governing Open Meetings requires advance public notification of all Board meetings of publically funded entities so that interested members of the public may attend such meetings and observe the transaction of business. There is no state requirement allowing time for public comment at these meetings.

The Board of Directors of the Camden County Joint Development Authority has established a policy that provides an opportunity for public comment on relevant matters before the Board. Individuals wishing to address the Board on specific issues may do so by registering their intent via email or in person at least 48 hours in advance of any regularly scheduled meeting.

Registered individuals may address the Board during public comment time on the agenda and are limited to two minutes each. The total time allotted for public comment shall not exceed 30 minutes. Speakers will be recognized in the order they are registered. Written comments will also be accepted at that time. Given the natural time constraints of any meeting agenda, the Board Chair may opt to limit the number of speakers. The Chair may cease public comment should comments be deemed unrelated to the Board business or be considered disrespectful or libelous.

There should be no expectation of a response by Board members. The comment period is not a time for questions and answers or public debate. This period is for comment only.
